A large pool and wading pool are just the thing for a cool dip in the heat of summer for the whole family. The pool snack bar offers light refreshments to the poolside crowd during the day. Tennis players enjoy some of the best play anywhere on the four lighted courts. Golfers will find one of the more challenging courses in Pennsylvania when they tee off on the par 73, 18-hole course at the Club.

There is an excellent pro shop and driving range, as well as provisions for lessons at all levels of play.

In 1996, the four tennis courts were replaced with new Har-tru surfaced courts, making this the premier tennis facility in Franklin County. In 1997, major renovations were undertaken on the golf course, with the replacement of several greens and tee areas. In 1999, work was finished on the first major renovation of the Clubhouse since 1945. The improvements included a new kitchen and banquet facility, along with a complete makeover of the rest of the building. New locker rooms, lounges, pro-shop and social areas were also completed to make this the finest facility of its kind in the area.

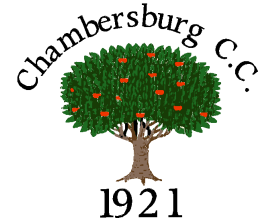
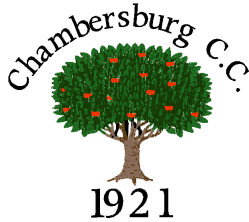

### Classification descriptions

**Non-Resident Golf**—This membership has residency restrictions: permanent residence must be at least 100 miles from Scotland, PA.

**Junior Family Golf Membership**— This membership allows for family access to the golf course, swimming pool, tennis courts, Clubhouse dining facilities and all social events hosted by the Club. “Family” includes husband, wife and children. The primary member must be between ages 21-30.

**Senior Golf Membership**— This membership allows access to the golf course for a single designated family member 75 years of age or older. It allows complete family access to the Clubhouse dining facilities and all social events hosted by the Club.

**Senior Family Golf Membership**— This membership allows for family access to the golf course, swimming pool, tennis courts, Clubhouse dining facilities and all social events hosted by the Club. The primary member must be 75 years of age or older.

**Golf Membership**— This membership allows access to the golf course for a single designated family member. It allows complete family access to the Clubhouse dining facilities and all social events hosted by the Club.

**Family Golf Membership**— This membership allows for family access to the golf course, swimming pool, tennis courts, Clubhouse dining facilities and all social events hosted by the Club.

**Corporate Golf Membership**— This membership allows for family access to the golf course, swimming pool, tennis courts, Clubhouse dining facilities and all social events hosted by the Club. This membership allows for complimentary guest fees for all persons playing in the Corporate Golf Member foursome. These persons are subject to cart rental fees. Contact the Business Office at (717) 263-8296 Ext. 221 for additional benefits available for this membership.

**Ala Carte Golf Membership**— This membership allows for individual access to the golf course, swimming pool, tennis courts, Clubhouse dining facilities and all social events hosted by the Club. All Club services are charged at the standard rate, per use at the time of usage.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Frequently Asked Questions - Chambersburg Country Club

**Q: What assessments am I subject to?**

A: The Board has placed into policy, for the membership cycles up to June 30, 2011, a non binding assessment clause. With this clause, the Board has stated that there will not be an assessment imposed upon the membership. In the event that something catastrophic were to happen and an assessment needed to be placed upon the membership, any member may resign the CCC at that time without having to pay the assessment and any dues that remain on their membership year.

**Q: I only golf April-October, is there a seasonal membership?**

A: There is not a "seasonal membership". All membership categories are annual memberships.

**Q: What privileges are extended to my family members? Grandchildren?**

A: Family privileges are extended to those with family memberships for children under 21 and grandchildren under 18 years of age.

**Q: How long am I committed to the Club?**

A: Membership commitments are for the membership year. Your commitment is from that date you join the club until the end of the membership year, which is currently June 30th of each year. You can resign at any time and you will only owe dues through that membership. The final month of every membership you will have the option to drop your membership and leave with no further obligation.

**Q: How do I resign?**

A: All resignation must be submitted in writing to the business office prior to the June Board of Governor's meeting for Board approval.

**Q: What are my guest privileges and at what rate?**

A: As a member you are entitled to sponsor guests to the club an unlimited number of times. However, a single individual is limited to a specific number of times they are allowed to use each area of the club. A single guest may only play golf 4 times in a calendar year. They will be charged standard rates to play.

**Q: What is the nominations process? Do I have to be interviewed?**

A: Each nominee for membership must have **two sponsors** who are current members in good standing. If a nominee does not know two current members, the membership committee may present the nominee as a club-sponsored member after conducting an interview with the nominee.

**Q: Can I take a leave of absence? What happens if I lose my job?**

A: Members requesting leave of absence for job relocation may be transferred to a non-resident membership with the residency requirements waived or to an A La Carte Membership. All other requests for leave of absence will be decided on a case-by-case basis by the Board of Governors.

**Q: What additional fees am I subject to?**

A: Optional additional fees could be incurred for cart rentals, swim & tennis usage, driving range usage, guest fees and handicap system fees. These are examples of possible fees. Other fees may exist.

### **Q: What are the new dues?**

#### **A: NEW DUES RATES AND CLASSES**

### **Q: What about the Food & Beverage Minimum and capital fees?**

A: Additionally, the Board of Governors is eliminating CAPITAL FEES and FOOD MINIMUM requirements as of July 1, 2010!

### **Q: When does this go into effect and how?**

#### **Current Members**

March 1, 2010 – eligible to fill out a new nomination form in the Business Office or Pro Shop to indicate which NEW class they are moving into. Each golfing membership will have a \$50 charge to their account in March to cover the mandatory range fee through June.

April 1, 2010 – members that filled out the new nomination form will be moved into their NEW CLASS and their dues will be billed accordingly.

July 1, 2010 – Food & Beverage minimums are removed. Mandatory range fee is removed.

#### **New/Past Members**

Immediately - prospective members are eligible to come into the Business Office or Pro Shop to fill out a nomination form to join the Chambersburg Country Club and to begin utilizing their membership, including golf, dining, swimming and tennis (when open for summer season and with the purchase of a seasonal pass if not included with the membership privileges) at the Chambersburg Country Club.

### **Q: What about current Associate Members?**

A: Associate Members can be grandfathered in at their current dues rates of \$250/monthly through June, 2011. They may indicate they wish to stay as Associate Members on the new nomination form they complete after March 1st.

### **Q: What about other categories that are no longer listed? Swim? Tennis? Dining? Social?**

A: All of these dues categories will have the option to switch to A La Carte membership (or any other categories) which will afford them the same club privileges. For many, this will be a huge savings.

### **Q: What if I do nothing?**

A: If you take no action, nothing will change for your membership. You will remain in your current class until June 30th, 2011 paying current dues, f & b minimums and capital fees. Your current privileges will remain. Remember, new dues will be billed out in April 2010 for those who choose to switch classes.
