General Information

All members must have an established official 18 hole handicap. 40 is the maximum number of strokes you will receive.

Members are responsible for signing up for all events through ForeTees online. If you cannot make the reservation online, please call by 2:00 pm on Monday. All pairings on Tuesdays will be made by golf shop. If there are less than 12 players the play of the day will be canceled.

Ringers and Birdies will be recorded by Dot Hill. The person designated as a BLIND will receive only ONE certificate- with either their winning team or the team they helped win. The awards presentation will be an evening banquet at the end of the season for the ladies 18 Hole Golf Group.

Jessie Rice Tournament

Dates:

Format: Best 2 Rounds of 3 (Low Net)

Eligibility: Must have 5 scores posted in 2016 & be an 18-holer

Pairings: 1st Round – Based on Handicaps, 2nd & 3rd Round – Based on Results

Ties: Broken by a hole by hole playoff immediately after the final round.

Rain: There will be no rain date. If only one round can be played due to weather and there is a tie, a match of cards will determine the winner.

Ladies Flights Championship

The format for the first through the fourth flights will be played in a Match Play Format and all the matches will be played with the difference in the player's handicaps. Flights are based on the handicap ranking of the players at the time of entry.

All players will be seeded according to handicaps. Matches will be played with the handicap as of the day of the match

All matches are requested to be played on other than Tuesdays. If a match is not played before the next scheduled match date, both players will be disqualified. Players must play in the same group at the same time.

Deadline to sign up for the Flights is August 11th, 2015. Matches must be completed by the published deadlines.

Ladies Club Championship

The Championship Flight will consist of all players who sign up to compete for the Ladies' Championship. The winner of this flight will have her name placed of the Championship Trophy and on the Championship Board in the Clubhouse.

The format in this flight will be match play and NO HANDICAPS will be used. This flight will be seeded by placing last year's Champion in the first seed and the remainder of the players will be seeded according to their handicaps.

There will be two separate sign up sheets, one for the Championship Flight and one for the remaining flights.

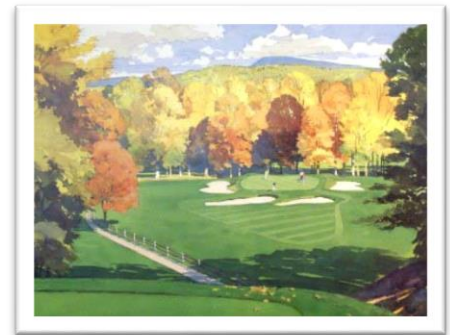

Event Schedule – Definitions

Best Ball Threesome- Players are paired in teams of three and their best ball on each hole is the team score.

Best Nine- Best Nine hole score of 18, you select the nine holes after the round.

S & T- Holes to be counted begin with the letters S & T. There are nine such holes. 2,3,6,7,10,12,13,16.

F & T- Holes to be counted begin with the letters F & T. There are nine such holes. 1,3,4,5,10,12,13,14,15.

Flight Tournament- Match Play

Blind Holes- Pro picks 9 holes to be counted and will inform the weekly chairperson when play is finished.

Beat the Pro- Players will match their score against the Pro.

Tee to Green- Players will count their score from the tee to landing on the green. Putts excluded.

Sadie Hawkins- Invite your favorite male golfer to join us. For match is Scotch-Twosome (Both players tee off, switch ball, both players hit 2nd shots, select the best 2nd shot and alternate strokes from then on until the hole is finished.

Scramble- Every player will drive the ball, choose the best shot, everyone will hit from there, and continue that same format until ball is holed.

Low Net- Count your net scores on every hole. Lowest net score will be the winner.

Count Putts- Individual with the lowest amount of putts on the greens will be the winner. (Handicap are not used)

New for the 2017 Season!

Criers Challenge- Each player substitutes the par score for their worst 3 holes before calculating their total score and using their full handicap.

Consecutive 3- Before play begins each player circles 3 consecutive holes on the scorecard, these will be thrown out at the end of the round, full handicap is used for the remaining 15 holes.

Select 9 (1/2 HC)- Before play begins, each player chooses any 9 holes where you think you will score well. They must include 1 par 5, 1 par 3, 7 par 4's. We will use ½ handicaps to score.

Scratch 3 – Throw out your 3 worst holes after the round before calculating your total score using your full handicap for the remaining 15 holes.

Handicap Scramble- A traditional scramble but strokes will be deducted at the end of the round based on team handicap as determined by the pro shop.

5 Easy Pieces- Pick 5 clubs from your bag which become the only clubs you can use the entire round. Strategy is important. Think and manage your way around golf course and be creative with your shots.
