The Ladies' 9-Hole Golf Association welcomes all golfers to the 2017 golf season. We would especially like to welcome all new members joining us this year. You will meet many new friends with whom you may spend some lovely summer days, golf club in hand, taking in the beauty of our course.

Annual, non-refundable dues for the Ladies 9-hole group are \$45, which cover the cost of weekly prizes, and other expenses throughout the season. For an additional \$2, you may participate in the Ringer Board competition. Each player enters her best Tuesday gross scores for the season on the ringer board and the winners at the end of the season split the "pot".

Our opening luncheon will be held **Tuesday, April 4 at 11:30 am** in the club dining room. Regular play will begin on Tuesday, April 11th and continue each Tuesday through October 10th. Our ending luncheon will be October 17th, 2017 at 11:30 am.

We will again be using a shotgun start this season. Please be at the pro-shop **at least 20 minutes before tee time** each Tuesday that we play. This will give you time to see the listing of playing partners and to receive instructions for the play of the day. Club Reminders

- Shotgun start will be **9:00 am for April/May/Sept/Oct** and **8:30 am for June/July/August**. Allow enough time for preparation and be at the pro-shop at least 15 minutes before start time for instructions for the day. If you have to cancel, are running late, or in doubt about the weather, please call the pro shop (263-8296 ext 223).
- Sign up for tee times by 6 am Tuesday online at www.foretees.com/chambersburgcountryclub** (enter your account # +a as login and your last name as password) or call the golf shop 263-8296 ext 223.
- If riding in a golf cart, please check with the pro shop for daily rules. Obey signs on the course. Use paths where provided. Keep carts off the approach to all greens. Never park in front of a green. Remember to sign for the cart in the pro shop before playing.
- Play ready golf. Be ready to hit your ball when it is your turn. Limit the search for a lost ball to three minutes.**
- Respect the course and your fellow players. Replace all divots, rake the sand traps and repair ball marks on the green.
- Scoring:
Gross score is the actual number of strokes taken. **If not on the green after ten strokes, please pick up the ball to help speed of play.** If you pick up, and it does not affect the Play of the Day, you are still eligible for that prize.
Net score is your gross score minus your handicap.
Adjusted score is the score given by the computer after posting.
A "whiff" is counted as one stroke.
- On the green:
Never step in the line of someone's putt. **Never** stand directly behind or in front of someone who is putting. **Repair all** ball marks, yours and any others.
- In case of a storm, the horn will sound. **Stop play immediately and seek shelter!**

Useful Information

The Ladies' 9-Hole Golf Association has a bulletin board in the ladies' locker room. On this bulletin board, you will find all the necessary sign-up sheets for invitational's, ringer board and information for other upcoming events.

Plays of the Day – Each week we play a different format and award prizes to the winners. Prizes will also be awarded for birdies and chip-ins. (Descriptions of different formats are listed below.) The formats are designed to highlight individual & team efforts and different golf skills (putting, driving, short game), as well as to “take the pressure off” and emphasize the fun.

Invitational – An invitational is a golfing event sponsored by another club's 9-hole group that sends out invitations to other clubs for participants. On the invitational sheet, you will find the date, time, cost and number that may attend from our club. These invitationals usually include lunch. All invitational information we receive will be posted on the bulletin board. Date, cost and entry deadlines will be highlighted. If you are planning to attend an invitational, please sign your name and see that our treasurer receives your entry fee **before the deadline**.

Ringer Board – The ringer board is also posted on the bulletin board. If you are participating in the ringer board play, you should post your individual gross scores in the boxes under each hole number (scramble or team scores do not count). As your score improves for each hole, erase the previous score and post your new score. **You may only post scores for Tuesday morning play**. At the end of the year, the best total score of each nine wins.

Handicaps – Each player should establish a handicap. You may do this by posting five scores in the computer in the pro shop. The pro shop staff will assist you in setting up for a nine-hole and/or an eighteen-hole handicap. Each time you play, be sure to enter your scores in the computer, good and bad. **For nine-hole play, thirty is the maximum handicap allowed.**

Flight Tournament - The Nine Hole Champion will be determined by averaging the best ten Nine Hole scores of the year.

Ladies' Golf Committee – Includes all lady golfers. This committee strives to improve communication with the board, pro shop and members. Any concerns should be brought to the attention of the chairpersons so that the committee can consider proper action.

Plays of the Day – Definitions

Scramble: Each player tees off. Then the group picks the best lie of all the shots. Everyone hits from that spot and so on until the ball is holed. Once the ball is holed out, that is the score for the team.

Variable Best Ball (1&2): Variable Best Ball, 1 Best Ball on the first hole, 2 on the second, 1 on the third, 2 on the fourth, and repeat until finished with 9.

Texas Scramble: Everyone in the group tees off and scramble to the best shot. From there each player plays their own ball until holed out.

Best Ball Threesome (Foursome): Best net score, per hole, of the threesome (or foursome).

Odd/Even Net: Partners are drawn and between them they will decide who will score on the odd holes and who will score on the even holes. (Subtract half of the combined handicaps.)

Low Net (Individual): Subtract net score from gross score. Best score wins.

Eliminate Three Holes: Throw out three worst holes.

Pink Lady: Each player in the group takes turns hitting the pink ball. Only the pink ball score is counted. Ball must be returned at the end of the round.

Odd Holes: Lowest total score on odd numbered holes.

Count Putts: Lowest number of putts.

Most Net Pars: Subtract your handicap on each hole. Score pars

Guess Your Twosome Score: Both players guess their score before play. Closest guess to the combined score wins.

Guess Your Score: Guess your score before play. Closest to the guess wins

Crier's Tournament: Individual net event – you get to change your worst two scores back to par

Count Tee to Green: Count the strokes from the tee to the green.

Three Blind Holes: The golf pro will decide which holes will count (net score).

Five Clubs and a Putter: Choose any five clubs you would like to play with and your putter. Take all the other clubs out of your bag.

Choice of Five to Score: Each player selects her five best holes.

Sadie Hawkins/Scotch Twosome: Invite a male to play (Also open to players without male partners). Both players hit from tee. Each plays the other's second shot. Choose best ball and alternate hitting until the ball holes out. Subtract half of combined handicaps.

Even Holes: Lowest score on even numbered holes.

Beat the Pro: Players will match their scorecard against the Pro.

Mystery Play: To be determined by Pro
